ROLE

The role of the Utility Labour Position is to perform general labour and load out duties in a safe manner in the operation of a Silica Sand Mine & Plant. The Utility Labourer must work within and comply with HCA Mountain Minerals (Moberly) Ltd. Safety Procedures. This is a full-time operation with rotating shifts. Ideal candidates would live within close proximity to Golden/Moberly, B.C. or be willing to relocate.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for operating various equipment in a safe and appropriate manner in a Silica Sand Processing Operation.
- Responsible for sprinkler relocation, carry tools, load rail cars
- Ensures plant is tidy (cleanup, pressure wash, etc)
- Record basic data as required and complete punch list tasks
- Required to perform preventative maintenance on equipment as needed (i.e. change pump seals, fan belts, greasing, etc.)
- Required to operate skid steer, forklift, etc.
- Troubleshooting in regards to assisting in the control room, monitor systems, fire watch, etc.
- May be required to relieve others as needed for breaks, etc.
- Performs assignments outlined by supervisors in a safe manner and ensures standard procedures are followed in compliance with company policies.
